Positively Putney Business Improvement District (BID for short) would like to welcome you to Putney town centre. We are delighted that you have chosen Putney for your business and look forward to working with you in creating a trading environment which will help your venture prosper.

WHAT IS A BID?

Your business is situated in Putney's Business Improvement District (BID) area, one of over 300 BID schemes now operating in the UK. A BID is a business funded and business led not-for-profit company, helping a local business area to thrive. We provide business support in various ways to businesses who are within a certain geographic area. BIDs have been operating across the UK for over a decade, and there are over 300 BIDs set up around the UK. Other local successful BIDs include Love Wimbledon and Kingston First.

HOW IS A BID FORMED?

Every five years a BID will go to 'BID Ballot', and the businesses vote yes or no to having a BID in their area. The council will issue voting papers that are delivered to the business premises. If a majority yes vote is achieved, then a BID will run for a 5-year term in the area. The businesses, whether they voted yes or no all pay into the BID, the amount is a small levy based on their rateable value and they pay this once a year. This is a mandatory payment.

POSITIVELY PUTNEY BID INFORMATION

- We are in our second term as a BID, after a successful YES vote in 2021. This means your BID will run from 2022-2027 currently
- Positively Putney is the trading name of Putney BIDCO Ltd, the not for profit limited company delivering the BID business plan
- Businesses with a rateable value of £12,000 and over (2017 ratings list) are billed for the BID levy billed on 1st April each year. The Levy Bill is based on 1.27% (or 1.02% for Putney Exchange businesses due to paying a management fee in the centre) of the 2017 rateable value of your business value
- Your levy payment will be combined with those of 399 other Putney businesses and pays to deliver the projects and services for the benefit of Putney Town Centre
- Over the 5 years £1.5 Million will be invested into the business community in Putney town centre
- All services are in addition to those already delivered by the local authority
- All activity is focused exclusively within the BID area and based on the needs of the business community

These services are all additional to those provided by the local authority and the BID does not fund services already in place.

The Directors all run businesses and organisations in the town centre. Together they are responsible for the strategic direction of the company and ensuring the delivery of the key project areas contained in the Positively Putney BID business plan.
